Max of 5 prize tickets given out to winner of each game. Each grade level must recruit 2 volunteers.

6. Prize Booth

- a. Prize booth to Main Office. Use "holding tank" (between double doors) for line, set ticket counting tables outside holding tank. Have three areas of prizes, on counter with identical prizes to help move line along. Gatekeeper at door.
- b. Sort, Organize, and Label
- c. Prize Workers 4/5 in 1 hr. blocks Using Sign-up Genius
- d. Prize booth will only be open from 6-8

7. Silent Auction -

- a. Located in front lobby
- b. One item per teacher/team
- c. Sign-up sheet for baskets/items in office
- d. Bid Sheets (Value, Minimum Bid, Cell Number)
- e. Pay & pick up by Thursday . Jan. 31st Cash or Credit only, Square available

8. Booth Layout -

- a. Area being used Everywhere!!!
- b. Hallway from the middle school doors to the doors to 1st grade – one side of the hallway will be for games to allow traffic to flow.
- c. Middle School hallway
- d. Ticket purchasing Concession Stand

9. Food Booths

 Boosters – Cafeteria, Get menu items and price info to include on form. Food is cash only, no tickets. Boosters does have a card machine now.

10. Advertising

- a. Front electronic sign, FB, Remind App, newsletter, order forms
- b. Banner on fence, contact Colleen Brazelton for a new one
- c. Put In Cups in fence
- d. Free game ticket for teachers to give to students, including special teachers, admin, and cafeteria monitors.
- e. Pre-Order form
- f. Food options on flyer, get from booster

11. Items to be purchased:

- a. Prizes varying in value
- b. Tickets, two colors (LOTS of them), at least 18,000.
- c. Blue bracelets for bouncy house
