- 3. Projects/Annual Events:
  - a. Smart Card Report: Overall sales were down just a little from last year, but with the price increase our result was about the same. 205 cards were sold, making our sale go over our goal of \$2,000 for a total of \$2,545. The homeroom teacher will receive \$1 for each card sold, so a net of \$2,340 for PTO.
  - b. T-shirt: Baseball style ¾ sleeve Great style, everyone LOVES!!! 251 were ordered in the first round including 100 ordered by Mrs. Ferrell for staff. We sold out of Youth Small and Adult Mediums. A second order of 62 has been placed to fill additional orders (34) and have some on hand to sell. Possible ideas for a spring tshirt are a limited addition "I survived the construction" theme.....
  - c. possible idea fundraisers to go January are bags and water tumblers and COE decals
  - d. Donation Fundraiser: Due to construction making our building/parking unavailable for fall festival, the PTO officers recommend we have a straight donation request fundraiser. See details below.
  - e. Winter T-shirts January long-sleeve/short sleeve option for shirts. Discussion: Colors, design, style, additional items?
  - f. Valentines Carnation Sale: Send home Wednesday, January 28, due Thursday, February 12. Will fill orders if extras are available on Friday, Feb. 13., End on Feb 12th
  - g. Fern Sale: March April Time frame- A co-leader is needed for this event.
  - h. Teacher Appreciation Week May 4-8. Co-leaders to organize the menus and volunteers are needed.
  - i. Field Day: PTO will work with school staff to host a Field Day and make t-shirts available.
  - j. 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Give Back Day: Officers Recommend we work with teachers to do this again. The teachers were fabulous and the students seemed to have a great time. Note: over half of the students came even though they had 8<sup>th</sup> grade graduation the night before.

- b. Mrs. Melissa Williams Library Battle of the Books list: New list each year for middle school students to for teams of 5 to read the 20 books and enter the challenge. Titles Include: <u>Brown Girl Dreaming</u>; <u>Centaur Rising</u>; <u>The Crossover</u>; <u>Dangerous</u>; <u>The Geography of You and</u>?; <u>Iam Malala: How One Girl...</u>; <u>The Night Gardener</u>; <u>Saving Lucas Biggs</u>; <u>Upside Down in the Middle</u>; <u>The Witch's Boy</u>; <u>Zombie Baseball Beatdown</u>. Annual event but books may/will change \$337.20 <u>DENIED</u>
- c. Mrs. Lori Maasen –3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Math "Card Stock Paper to make 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade student task cards station activities, & partner games targeting 3<sup>rd</sup> grade skills". First year teaching 3<sup>rd</sup> grade math; \$50. APPROVED

Nurse Annette Sells Clinic Fridge with Freezer in top 2 door (separate freezer unit)- for storing student medication, ice packs for injuries, and juice/drinks for diabetics \$149- needs by August 1, 2015- location change with the new building will not put her as close to the fridge/freezer she currently uses. #### **Donation Fundraiser:**

Date: October 1 – packets go home; due November 3 (to allow multiple paychecks)

Packet: Envelope and sheet (or printed on envelope) for listing student name, teacher, etc. and

How to split?

Amount: 50% or 50% up to set dollar amount (ex. \$150)

K-2 Homeroom teachers – stay with same teacher all day

3 – 8 swap classes/have multiple teachers

Specials teachers (Library, Music, PE, Computer, Art, Band)
Specialty Teachers (Speech, ESL, Title, Guidance, Special ED)

How to split among groups? Classroom, Specials, Specialty, PTO

Approved

Option 1: Homeroom teacher gets 50%; nothing for specials or specialty; 50% PTO

Option 2: 50 % Divided among a student's classroom teachers; nothing for specials or specialty; 50 % PTO

Option 3: 40% classroom (however), 10% of rest split among specials and specialty, 50%

Option 4: 40% Classroom, 7% Specials, 3% Specialty; 50% PTO
