#### 1. TREASURER'S REPORT + CURRENT BALANCE

- a. Current Balance \$28,742.34

- b. <u>Spirit Items</u> In Progress! There is not a book to look at with SPI. He did send a new online book to look at apparel options. His designers are both out with covid right now, so he didn't have any eagle designs to send me. We have received some shirt ideas to look at. We are discussing selling more than shirts, like beanies, scrunchies, cups, shorts, socks, pop sockets, apple watch bands. They do not have an online store for parents to order from. **Replacing the trees on the playground -** Tausha Grady - I got a quote from my landscaper, This is for the Autumn Blaze Maple trees

1.5" Trunk Ball in Burlap - (Probably close to 6-7 foot tall), Provided and Planted with a bag of mulch around the base= \$250/each (\$750)

<u>2" Trunk B&B -</u> (Probably 7-8 foot), Provided and Planted with a bag of mulch around the base = \$325/each (\$975) Officially voted to go with this option, but need to check into stump grinding and guarantee first. Need to get this done asap before it gets warm.

Just the plants delivered to the school:

3 of the 1.5" Maples = \$500

3 of the 2" Maples = \$625

A 2" ABM tree at <u>Needhams</u> is \$225. Online prices for Autumn blaze maples seem similar to his, but are the wholesale nurseries cheaper? I remember someone talked about them being in McMinnville in the meeting maybe.

**Kindergarten Teacher Lounge -** Beth will get this project started by talking with the Kindergarten teachers to get an idea of what's needed and storage units they like.
