1. TREASURER'S REPORT + CURRENT BALANCE

a. **Current Balance - \$31,972.23**

2. PROJECTS + ANNUAL EVENTS:

- a. <u>Mum Sale</u> We sold 1,363 this year. 857 regular /636 premium. Profit should be just over \$12,000. Delivery day is Friday, October 1st. <u>We need Volunteers to unload trucks in the morning and help load cars in the afternoon.</u> We did purchase two signacades for the parking lot. Yay! Not counting extras that a few people ordered.
- b. <u>Playground Shade</u> Over Picnic Tables. We voted and Approved \$10,000. The prices are: 1) 20x20 shade that would go beyond the current concrete slab is slightly over budget at \$11,100. 2) 20x15 to cover current concrete slab (with about 2.5 feet of the slab not under the shade) and stay under budget is \$9,800. So, we need to vote to raise the budget for the larger shade option, or stay within the budget for the smaller shade option. Passed to raise the budget. Neva made a motion and Doug 2nd. All for, none apposed.
- c. <u>Bench on Playground at Basketball court</u> The playground company says they are not able to fix it. To replace it costs: 1) They ship to us and we do the work: \$5,275. 2) They do it all (maybe not possible if the vendor has to be approved) \$6,875. Price other benches this is too costly.
- d. <u>Coats</u> for car line workers. Ordered 10 coats \$1600. Where and how to hang them to keep? Behind the stage, as you go out of the student entrance. Label by size for quick access.
- e. **Spirit Items** We are discussing selling more than shirts, like beanies, scrunchies, cups, shorts, socks, pop its. No date yet. If anyone wants to take point on this, it would be greatly appreciated.
- f. **PTO Shirts -** We are designing a new PTO crew shirt. Just for PTO members that would like one. Buy our own shirt, not a fundraiser so it will not be going through the pto accounts.
- g. **Student of the Month** Started today, new certificates designed by Nikki. Signs to K-5 and Chick-fil-A \$5 gift cards to middle school students. Jessie made a photo to post on facebook.
- h. Winter Carnival May combine with X-STREAM night in the Spring. On Hold
- i. **Fern & Mixed Basket Sale** April- Always a huge fundraiser! Last year we sold 3,600 plants and made a profit of \$20,632.
