Suggested last month: American Sycamores grow 3-6 feet per year, Red Maples, or Leyland Cypress which is an Evergreen tree, PinOak??? After discussing, it seems the Red Maple is going to be the better option. Tausha Grady has volunteered to take over this project! Mr. Doug recommended going to the flea market in Lebanon to purchase the trees. Maybe buy some mulch and water bags to help keep the trees watered.

Kindergarten Teacher Lounge. Beth will get this project started by talking with the Kindergarten teachers to get an idea of what's needed and storage units they like. Cassie McNutt will help design the room.

Jennifer Jenkins outdoor picnic tables - Like the ones outside already to put on concrete area out by 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade hall.

Brandi Hammond outdoor picnic tables - Would also like to add 4 of the same outside tables to the ones we already have so students can sit outside for lunch as a reward for different things.

New request- Plan a Campus Cleanup day - to tear down the wooden shed by pre-k, fix and paint rusting benches, install pavers by kids club & pre-k door. Plant trees? Put together tables? Since it is better to plant trees in the cold weather, we are hoping to get the trees planted asap. The group discussed planning the cleanup day after Spring Break. Also, Robin suggested doing a trailer drop at the dump with the shed and everything else that needs to be disposed of. It only cost \$6 or so.
