2. Treasurer's Report, Current Balance & Budget Approval, see attachment

- a. Current Balance \$19,934.02
- b. <u>Review Budget</u> Budget was prepared at officers meeting, review and approval. Approved, no objections.
- c. <u>Funding Request Procedures</u> All requests MUST be turned in to the PTO <u>No Later</u> than one week before the next meeting. Criteria that will be looked at when considering requests involvement in PTO meetings and activities, Winter Carnival participation, and number of students that will benefit from the request. I will email the teachers a copy of the new fillable form to submit by email.
- d. <u>Fundraisers for small groups/clubs within the school.</u> The PTO can help facilitate fundraisers for other groups in the school. We can help with collecting the funds and paying vendors. It will be up to the teacher or administrator of each group to get their students and parents to do the leg work (selling, sorting, distributing).

- a. <u>Smart Card Sale</u> Not selling smart cards this year due to the start of school being delayed and the Boo Bash fundraising beginning earlier. You can still order online and it will be mailed to you.
- b. <u>Student of the Month</u> Emails will be sent to teachers the 3rd week of every month by Nikki Cutter. (beginning the end of September) Pre-k thru 5th grade get signs sent home. - c. <u>Spirit Items</u> After the Mum sale ends,we will post the remaining spiritwear online for sale. Items with the year "2019" will be listed at a discount. Items purchased online will be sent home with students. No new shirts will be printed this year.
- d. <u>"Straight Outta Quarantine"</u> t-shirt sale started this past Monday. There were alot of parents asking for these shirts so we set up an online store. This is not a planned fundraiser, just providing a way for parents to purchase these shirts. It was also planned to have the C-O neck gaiters as well, but the neck gaiters are on backorder. Sale ends September 20th
- e. <u>Mum Sale</u> Selling 9 in. pots in white, yellow, purple, and bronze for \$12 each. We are selling them online, forms are also available, turn-in date of Sept. 8th, delivery date of Sept 18th. 1600 plants sold last year for a profit of \$9,233. Final number has to be turned in by September 10th. As long as there is no stay at home order, we will proceed like normal. Parent volunteers are needed. So far, 211 mums have been sold.
