- 2. PROJECTS + ANNUAL EVENTS:
 - a. <u>Spirit Items</u> –Remaining inventory of 2019 spiritwear will be available the day of the plant sale pickup. Sold 59 shirts and hoodies with the five day flash sale.
 - b. <u>Virtual Ideas</u> Easter egg decorations? Categories? Also discuss Flamingo Flocking, Egg hiding. PreK-5th grade Egg Decorating Contest - Most Creative, Best Book Character and Ugliest Egg. Maybe a teacher category. Hiding eggs and flocking flamingos at peoples homes for money - too hard to get volunteers
 - c. <u>Spring Carnival</u> Not needed between X-STREAM night, Field day and Awesomeness Day. Teachers did say that parents/kids really like principal for the day, SRO, Teacher for a day, etc... and they wouldn't mind doing this to raise classroom money. What about skipping the pickup line?
