- a. Current Balance - **\$17,553.54** Outstanding - \$4,107.50 Smart Cards Working Balance - **\$13,446.04**

- a. Smart Card Sale – Current status - Sold **377** cards, **27** books. Profit of **\$4,107.50**. (278) cards not returned.
